End of year letter from Founder, Jennifer Misfeldt

I want to first start with a big **THANK YOU** to all of those that sent in items from our wish list we posted in Dec 2019. It was our first year sharing with you a list of the many supplies we need/use throughout the year that many of times we purchased with monetary donations. [Click here to view our wish list](#)

Back in November 2005 MABTR became an official non-profit 501c3 organization that opened its hearts and homes to taking in Bostons (of any age, gender or special need) and Boston mixes that were in need of finding a new forever home. Over the years we have expanded our services across 13 states as the result of volunteer support. We have welcomed many volunteers into our family over the years, some of which are still with us today.

We have been so fortunate to have such great support that we will celebrate 15 years of service in 2020 with over 4000+ lives saved by end of year.

When I review monthly and yearly numbers I am taken back, even more when numbers are spoken out loud. There are so many moving parts to helping just one dog and yet this organization operates with such great success due to the dedication, timely responsiveness, professionalism and open communication by each member, volunteer, and supporter of MABTR.

Remember that MABTR is made up solely of volunteers, not one person is paid including myself. We do what we do because we love the Boston breed and know that all dogs deserve a safe and happy home.

90% of our foster parents, including myself, work a full time job outside of the home with no association to MABTR plus have families of our own. We say that MABTR is our full time non-paying job with no days off.

I am truly grateful for this wonderful family I am part of. Though I may had done the paperwork to get MABTR started there is no way I could do this alone. I truly appreciate the compliments and putting up with my shortness. No matter how much you do or did for MABTR every bit makes a difference to our success and the happiness of many lives that come across our path.

I want to take this time to address one question I am asked each year.

-What is MABTR's biggest challenge? My answer is:

- Always in need of **foster homes**. We cannot save a Boston if we have no foster home to place him/her in - we do not board or work out of a facility.
- We are especially in need of **foster homes that are petless**. Unfortunately not all Bostons are dog/cat friendly but yet are great companion pets.
- **Transporters** - we encourage all of you to share your travel plans by car with us as we are always moving a dog to or from foster care or closer to their forever home across 13 states. We will not fly our dogs. [Click here](#) to share your upcoming travel plans with us.

YEAR IN REVIEW MABTR 2019 Finances & 2020 Goals

MABTR is excited to start a new year. 2019 was crazy busy with many rewards, challenges, and new friends and fans.

Stats

In 2019 we saved 303 lives (10% increase from 2018). Thank you to everyone involved as this would not have been possible without you!!

Recap

- 22 (7%) of the 303 were Boston mixes
- 21 (7%) of the 303 passed away in 2019 (four after adoption and three while in Palliative Care)
- 17 (5.6%) of the 3030 were placed in Palliative Care
- Age break down for intakes (count / % of the 303):
under a year: 63 / 21%; 1 to 5 yrs: 143 / 47%; 6 to 8 yrs: 42 / 14%; 9 to 11 years: 43 / 14%; 12 and older: 12 / 4%

We are proud to state that we rescued **157 puppy mill survivors** in 2019. This is our biggest bucket at 52% of our 2019 intake. This is a 5% decrease from 2018. We hope to see this number continue to drop over the year which in return means less dogs being bred and the public adopting more. The key is for the public to not shop but to adopt reducing the demand which in return requires supply. MABTR prides itself on the ability to give commercial breeder (puppy mill) dogs a second chance at life. [Click here to learn more about puppy mills.](#)

Our second largest intake for 2019 were **owner surrenders at 32%**. 96 dogs that were handed over to us by their owners or MABTR solicited them as the dog was being sold online (i.e. craigslist, Facebook). No change from last year in the

percent of owner surrenders. We want to continue encourage families that our services exist when needed especially as an alternative to selling your beloved pet online to someone you meet in a parking lot and never validate what they say over the phone is true.

Our last category for intakes are those from a shelter. MABTR took in **50 dogs from local shelters**; this is an increase from 2018. We continue to build relationships with local shelters as we know not all dogs will thrive in such an environment and space is always an issue. We take in those that are deemed unadoptable due to health or behavior and when the shelter is in need of space.

2019 Financial Report

*We currently have 10 dogs in foster care (eight not ready to be placed due to age or health evaluation). \$8,577 of uncollected adoption fees are from those still in foster care and for adoption fees yet to be collected (this could due to the dog still in their trial period or adopter is past due).

We experienced a 5% increase in medical expenses. The increase came from owner surrenders and shelter dogs. It is unfortunately how many owners to not provide their pets with the medical care needed such as dentals, regular check ups including bloodwork, treatment of infections, and the list goes on. We also had a few land in hospice after multiple tests for a final diagnosis.

Remember that just because a dog is young does not guarantee he/she will live to be 14. MABTR cannot promise anyone how long a dog will live. We unfortunately have experienced the loss of a life at a very young age unexpectedly.

A **big THANK YOU** to our event coordinators across multiple states that helped raise 33% of our cash flow and to our monetary donors that make up 28% of our cash flow. Medical expenses made up 85% of our expenses this year with adoption fees only making up 39% of the coverage of the medical costs.

2020 Goals

With every successful organization there are goals to be achieved in order for our mission to be accomplished together. MABTR's family and efforts will continue to grow and accomplish the following goals in 2020.

1. Grow our **foster homes** including foster homes with no other pets. Always at the top of our list. MABTR cannot operate without foster homes. The more foster homes we have, the more Boston Terriers we can save. We are actively seeking foster families in Colorado, Kansas, Iowa, Missouri, Nebraska, South Dakota and Wyoming. 2. Build our volunteer base. Volunteers are needed in the areas of helping at local events in Kansas city, Omaha and Colorado
3. Increase transport offers as finding drivers to help can be a struggle when we service 13 states. No dog is transported by plane . We will reach out to you if the route is needed.
4. Fill the following open position of:
 1. Communication admin
 - this individual will be responsible for scheduling email messages using Constant Contact. You will be properly trained to use Constant Contact which you access online.


Obesity



Obesity is an extremely common problem in pets and, as with humans, is detrimental to the health of a dog. Obesity shortens a dog's life and makes them more likely to develop diseases.

Increased risk for dogs overweight: * cancers of all types * diabetes * heart disease * high blood pressure * arthritis earlier in life * bladder stones

Body Condition Scoring Chart



Identify the reason for the extra weight

We cannot assume that your dog is overweight due to overfeeding. Diseases can cause weight gain and it is important to eliminate medical cause before moving onto a change in life style. Obesity may be an indicator of diseases such as hypothyroidism (an underactive thyroid gland) or Cushing's disease (overactive adrenal glands). Only your vet can test and diagnosis these diseases.

The very first step in dealing with an overweight dog is to recognize and acknowledge that there is a problem. Then you move onto to a life style change that will include exercise and a weight management diet that you as the pet owner need to follow. The goal is to reduce calorie intake correctly and increase your dog's physical activity.

It is not appropriate to simply reduce the volume of food you feed your dog. This will cause malnutrition over time and organ damage. It is important to feed a nutritional product that is lower in calories, yet maintains an appropriate nutrient balance. Most dog brands now carry a line of weight management food. We recommend dry kibble over canned food. Also important is providing the right portion of food two to three times a day. One meal a day puts the body in starvation mood.

Humans find themselves displaying love to their dog by giving them extra food, treats, and human food (higher in calories and fat than pet food) which is actually shortening their lives with us. Not all human foods are bad for dogs but you need to know what is healthy and what is not. The healthy foods make great snacks for in between meals or replacement for treats that will keep your dog's stomach feeling content. Think healthy treats such as fresh or frozen fruits and vegetables. Also look for Low Sugar products.

Exercise

Many pet owners hope a run in the yard however this this is not enough exercise to keep him healthy. Dogs require our participation and interaction. Some dogs love to swim, others prefer to fetch, and some breeds do best with a physical job. For many dogs, however, a simple daily walk is all that is required for them to stay at their ideal body weight
